SAFETY PROTOCOLS

PROGRAM DETAILS

Sundays

- First Sunday of the month with the main service. Students can sit together at 10:45 service.

- Components: Snack bar & Hang-out Time, Group Game, Spiritual Content, Small Group Discussions

- Small Groups will be organized by age. We will mostly be mixed-gender, but will split up by gender occasionally.
